Harvest Festival

On Monday 30th September we will be celebrating our Harvest Festival; weather permitting at St. Mary's Church. The service will start at 2.15pm and the children will walk to the service from school. The Class Teachers will need help chaperoning the children across the fields to church. If you are able to help with this please speak to your child's Class Teacher by Thursday 26th September. School Uniform
