## Hair

We have recently had several cases of head lice in school. Please check your child's hair today and apply treatment if necessary. A weekly hair check is a good routine to get into. We ask that all children with hair longer than shoulder length, boys or girls, have it tied back while in school both to avoid nits being passed from one head to another and for safety in lessons such as PE and Design Technology.
