Please read the attached information about Free School Meals and Pupil Premium. Please fill in and return the form especially if you are in receipt of any of the benefits listed, whichever year group your child is in. Barcombe School could receive  $\pounds 1,300$  extra funding per year per child to help support extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities. This is particularly important in light of the letter you received on Tuesday about funding for schools. If your child is eligible now, the funding will be provided for the whole time your child is at Barcombe and he/she will be entitled to free school meals in Key Stage 2. If you are at all unsure, please come and talk to the office staff who will be able to help you.

### #FlatCashEd

Please consider writing to your MP about the Funding Formula for schools. You received a letter about it on Tuesday; an electronic copy is on the school website. We are very grateful to those parents who have said they will support this East Sussex campaign which could transform what is currently a bleak future into a much rosier one for our lovely school and its pupils.
