At a recent meeting we discussed school priorities for this year and ways our whole community can work together to help the school improve / address these. Through data analysis the school has identified our girls are outperforming our boys in writing at Key Stage One and our boys are outperforming our girls in Maths at Key Stage Two. The school has made a number of changes to the planning and delivery of our lessons to ensure each focused group improve their performance in the future. Throughout the beginning of next year curriculum leaders will also be organising parent workshops to help parents realise how we teach key skills at school. These workshops will focus on:

The Teaching of Phonics – Wednesday 22nd January (4.30 – 5.30pm) Development in the Teaching of Calculation – Wednesday 5th February (4.30 – 5.30pm) Engaging children in Writing – Wednesday 5th March (4.30 – 5.30pm)

The School will also be holding a Visioning day on Monday 6th January during a whole school INSET. The new Parent Representatives have been asked to feed back any ideas you as parents have as to what you would like our school to look like in three years' time! I would greatly appreciate any comments you would have in relation to developing a new school vision as these will form part of the discussions on the day.

As mentioned in previous newsletters, if you are able to give up a small part of your day to help the children with their reading we would really appreciate it.
