NEW: Social skills club for kids!

Making jokes, starting conversations, being a good friend - the social world can be hard for any child to navigate, but especially for those with autism and social communication difficulties. The good news is that there's lots we can do to help children learn these skills.

Social Detectives is a fun-filled after-school course that helps primary-aged children develop their social skills in a safe and friendly setting, run by specialists in autism and communication difficulties.

Already well established in Brighton, Social Detectives is now coming to Lewes in October 2017, through a collaboration between iContact, the Teaching and Learning Collaboration and South Malling C of E Primary School.

Sessions are run in small groups (to a maximum of 8 plus up to 4 siblings). Parents set goals for their child at the start of the course and activities are tailored to individual needs.

Place: South Malling Community C of E Primary School

Time: From 4.00 for a 4.30 start, ends at 6.00

Dates: Thursday afternoons: 12, 19 October and 2, 9, 16, 23, 30 November

Cost: £42 per child for 7 sessions. Children are encouraged to attend all sessions. Free spaces to a limited number of siblings or friends without communication difficulties. Parents are encouraged to stay to meet other parents and watch the sessions so they can continue the learning at home.
