## What are we thinking about in each session?



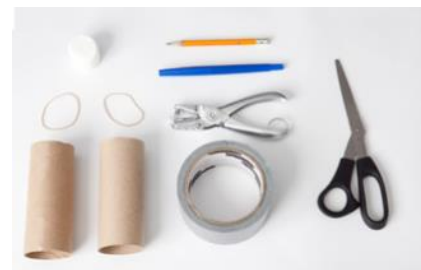
We are going to follow the Messy Church sessions each month this year, with craft / game / story.
