 As one of only six successful bids from 427 applications to Nesta's Share Lab fund, we

are pleased with our new forum offering a platform for prisoners' families to confide in each other, tell their story and get the support they need. At the time their loved one received a custodial sentence, families reported how their trauma and anxiety made it difficult to read leaflets or text-based advice. So, family members came together recently to create blogs and short films that are being shared on the forum. They are pleased that their voices are being heard, and hope others won't have to go through the same things that they have had to go through.

"We need to reach people who are hidden away or feel embarrassed about having a loved one in prison. We want to show that we're ordinary people out there who are struggling and we want to eradicate this stigma and get people using the support that is available and to get involved"

HMP Lewes family visits centre

We've been working closely with the prison staff, and the new family service provider Spurgeons, with the centre now open during visiting times offering a warm place to wait with tea, coffee, snacks, toys for the children and a listening ear. Families tell us that while visits can be hard, the new visitors' centre makes the experience a little easier, and new visitors are particularly grateful having a friendly face to show them around and explain the visiting process and systems.



A visitor came into the centre to say she was really anxious about the visit as she had never been in a prison before and was worried as she didn't know what to expect. Volunteers talked her through exactly what would happen at each stage. She came back to tell us that she felt much happier about going into the prison as a result of this help. "It made me feel less stressed. And it was all much better than I thought."


