In addition, this year we are also focusing on the following: Maths (and the continued use of Times Tables Rockstars), Writing, Sporting opportunities and the continued promotion of Kindness.

Attendance

This week's attendance winners are Fox Class with an outstanding 100% attendance record. Well done, Foxes! Squirrels and Owls are close behind with 99.6% and 99.3% respectively.

Our overall attendance currently stands at 98.2% which exceeds our aim of 97%. Thank you.

Safety measures - reminder

- Pupils will arrive at school and leave school according to the staggered times;
- Indoors, pupils will remain in consistent class bubbles throughout the school day;
- Pupils will play in year group bubbles and in zones during play times and lunch times;
- G-Suite log-ins have been provided in case of localised/national lockdowns or closure of class bubbles in the future;
- Classrooms will be well-ventilated;

- Visitors will wear masks in communal areas of the school.
- School Staff wear face coverings on the school gate and the beginning and end of the day;
- It is recommended that parents and carers also wear face coverings when dropping-off and picking-up.
