We are aware that not all children are benefitting from the daily mile as an exercise programme and are currently exploring ways in which we can engage every child in heart-rate-raising activities every day. Please be assured that the daily mile has not been cancelled; we are just currently exploring the children's response to lots of different activities.

Royal Tea Party

There will be an open afternoon on October 6th when parents will be invited into school to join our Royal Tea Party – dressing as a King or Queen if you would like to! This will be similar to the hat-making activity from a couple of years ago: children will work with their parents to create a family coat of arms using all sorts of materials. Safety on the way to and from school

It has been brought to our attention that several children are riding bikes at speed along School Path at the beginning and end of the school day, sometimes narrowly missing hitting parents and children who are walking along the road. There are also often cars on this road which makes it doubly dangerous. Please ensure that your child rides slowly along School Path, showing awareness of others, and that he/she wears a cycle helmet.

Barcombe Fun Sports Afternoon

Please support the village fun sports afternoon this Sunday. The weather forecast looks good for it so get out onto the Rec and enjoy the sunshine and some sports!

Please be vigilant and make sure that children are kept off school for sickness and diarrhoea. Infections can spread very rapidly in a school environment and we want all the children to be as healthy as possible.

Uniform and PE kits

The children look very smart in their new uniforms. We would like to remind you that our uniform is black shoes. Trainers are not to be worn during the school day except for playtime or PE. On Fridays, we will continue with our slipper days as voted for by the children last year.
