Coats and Shoes

The weather is becoming colder and wetter. Please ensure that your child has a warm, waterproof coat to wear when they are outside for playtimes and lunchtimes. Also, please ensure that their shoes are appropriate for winter conditions. We want our children dressed appropriately for the weather and the activities that they are doing.

Eligibility for Free School Meals

All children in Reception, Year I and Year 2 are currently entitled to free school meals.

Your child may be entitled to free school meals for <u>all</u> their time at Primary School.

If you are in receipt of Income Support, Income-based Jobseekers Allowance, Income related Employment and Support Allowance or some other form of support, your child may be entitled to free school meals throughout primary school and possibly beyond.

If your child does qualify, they also receive Pupil Premium funding for at least 6 years. This funding is used to support children's learning and help towards the cost of, for example, school uniform, after school clubs and school trips. If you would like to apply for these 'long—term' free school meals you just need to complete a form that is available from the school office.

Remember, if you are in receipt of benefits, you need to register for free school meals, even if your child is in Reception, Year I or Year 2 to ensure they receive free meals beyond Year 2, and also for your child to receive the pupil premium funding.

Fire Station Visit

Hedgehogs, Squirrels and Badgers recently visited Barcombe Fire Station as part of their Fire! topic. They enjoyed finding out all about the job of firefighters and asked some fantastic questions.



Reading Challenge

Our Reading Challenge continues this term with children receiving a token every time they read at home four or more times in a week. Please keep working hard with this at home – reading is such an important skill to master. We look forward to presenting more book tokens at the end of this term.

Children in Need

Everyone looked wonderful in their wacky clothes on Children in Need Day. Thank you for helping us support this day. We raised almost £150 which is fantastic for a little school.
