
<u>Phonics Twilight</u> → Wednesday 27th April – 5.30pm. Come and find out about our new phonics scheme.

Mathematical Development

During Maths this term, we will be focusing on Position and Direction, learning about prepositions and positional language whilst reading 'Rosie's Walk' by Pat Hutchins.

We will also be learning about the concept of Mass and Weight during the Summer Term. The children will learn how to use balance scales and electronic scales, even leaning how to weigh some items in grams!

We shall also be exploring the concept of Capacity throughout the summer, thinking about how much water we can fit inside a container.

Our Project is... Let's Create 'Music'

In term 6 we will be getting to know the percussion instruments and how to play them in different ways. Using them to add sound effects to stories and songs.

We will be learning a Goldilocks song using Makaton signs to go with it.

We will enjoy listening to music and talk about what we hear and feel. When we analyse some African music, we will make comparisons with the different percussion instruments used.

Phonics - We are becoming experts at Rocket Phonics: enjoying the interactive resources and independent worksheets.

Reception children are working in phase 3 and Y1 children continue through phase 5 whilst recapping some of the diagraphs and practising tricky words.



Science

In science we will be learning about the life cycle of a butterfly by hatching our own caterpillars and watching what happens!

We will also be learning about plants, by planting our own seeds and flowers. We will see what happens when we give them sun, soil and water.

RE

We will be reading some of the stories about Jesus and thinking about how he was a leader and a teacher. We will be thinking about people we see as leaders and teachers in our own lives. We will be learning a song about Jesus and adding actions.

Language and Literacy

Inspired by our 'create' topic we focus on art with 'Matisse's Magical Trail' by Tim Hopgood. Matisse is a snail who creates great works of art in a school for the children to enjoy.

We will then look at the painter Matisse's work with scissors and find out about his life as a painter and how he changed his work. We move onto focusing on our butterflies and writing about the changes we saw.

After the break, our writing and musical focus we will be re-telling and innovating the story of Goldilocks and encouraging the children to have a go at a 'big write!' We will also be writing about similarities and differences in African music following a range of themed learning experiences.

Physical Development

In PE this term, we will be focusing on the games for our Sports Day events! We will practise being a good sportsman and cheering on our friends! We will be using a variety of equipment and skills for the different events. We will also be running our 'half mile' 3 times a week.

Our Project is... Portrait. Let's Create 'Art'

In term 5, we will be looking at some wonderful artists' work and having a go at using some of the key skills to create our own pieces. We start by reading a story about Henri Mattise, finding out about why he changed his style of art. We will be creating some pebble art, with facial features and emotions. We will be taking our own photographs using the Ipads, before using pens to make fun doodle art portraits of ourselves! We will be learning to look closely and talk about art by analysing and comparing portraits by Maria Rivans and Picasso.
