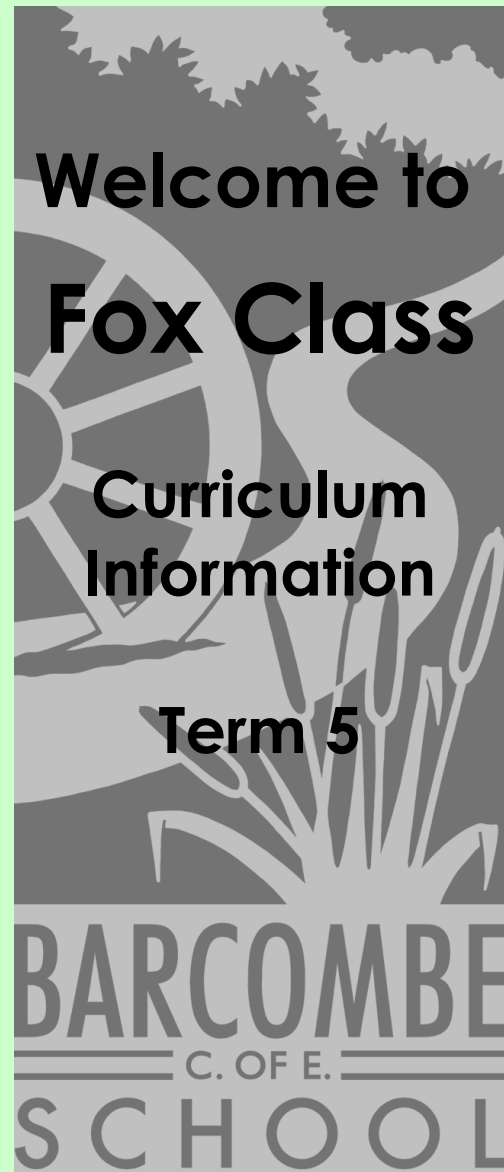
Here you will find daily learning activities for all the subjects you would normally be doing in school

ENGLISH

We will also post some spelling, punctuation and grammar activities for you to have a go at.

MATHEMATICS

Each day, a Problem of the Day will be posted. This is a way of applying learning that has been done in school throughout Years 3 to 5. Please comment on the posts each day to show your answers and your reasoning if you can. We will reply to you.

You will also find a number of the day website - mathsbot.com There are 4 levels of challenge for you to try. Start with level 1; the other levels include some questions for children much older than you!

A link to a maths lesson will be posted every day too. This will be a video lesson from a nationally-recognised maths teaching resource.
