Super Skylarks

Across the Skylark Federation, we are introducing the Super Skylark scheme. This will be for pupils in Year 5 and 6. A purple Super Skylark sweatshirt, to be worn instead of the green Barcombe sweatshirt as part of uniform, will be awarded to children who fulfil 'ten awesome things'. These include reading at home at least 4 times every week, showing evidence of regularly taking part in a club (at school or out-of-school), modelling environmental awareness, being polite, showing excellent behaviour and other similar awesome things.

Our attendance currently stands at 95.6%. This year, we aim to achieve higher than the DfE expectation of 97%. Inevitably, there will be times when your children are too ill to be in school, but we ask that our pupils are in school every day whenever possible to support us in our goal of 97%+.
